**Day 1, Feb 1st - Read the 1st section**

**Prayer: Jesus, Please Help me to be open to you speaking to me during these 28 days. Help me to be still and listen with respect and hunger for you.**

**Day 2, Feb 2nd - Read the 1st Section**

**Prayer: Jesus, please help me to see my life as you do.**

**Day 3, Feb 3rd - Read the 1st Section**

**Prayer: Jesus, Help me to allow you to examine the rooms of my life, and be excited about connecting deeper with you.**

- 1. If you are already a Christian, take a few minutes and write down what it was like when you invited Jesus into you heart. If you have not invited Jesus into your heart yet, take a few minutes and focus on John 3:16.**
- 2. Think about the rooms of your life. Have you ever thought of your life like this? Sincerely, do you think God knows and cares about each of the rooms?**
- 3. What area of your life do you wish that God would change you or help you with?**

**Scripture readings to think about: Galatians 2:20, Ephesians 3:14-19**



**Day 4, Feb 4rd - Read the 2nd Section 'The Study'**

**Prayer: Jesus, please look at my mind with me today.**

- 1. If you can imagine your mind as a study, or library, what books, magazines, pictures, and web-sites are you looking at?**
- 2. The author was embarrassed with some of his material. When he asked Jesus to "makeover" his library, what the things that Jesus said to throw out? Do you need to throw some things away?**
- 3. What are some items you could focus on to fill your 'study' with things that build your closeness to Jesus?**

**Scripture reading to think about: Philipians 4:8**

**Day 5, Feb 5th - Read the 2nd Section 'The Study'**

**Prayer: Jesus, please make my mind to be like your mind.**

- 1. After throwing out the material that was not true, good, pure, or helpful, what did Jesus tell the author to put on his empty shelves?**
- 2. Jesus told the author to fill the library with \_\_\_\_\_ and to \_\_\_\_\_ on them day and night.**
- 3. What are some other words for Meditate that you can think of?**
- 4. Do you want to live with the mind of Christ?**

**Scripture readings: Matthew 4:4. Consider this proverb...."As a man thinketh, so he is"**

**Day 6, Feb 6th - Read the 2nd Section 'The Study'**

**Prayer: Jesus, help every part of my mind to be under your control.**

- 2. What did Jesus give the author to help him control his images?**

**Day 7, Feb 7th - Read the 3rd Section 'The Dining Room'**

**Prayer: Jesus, help me to get real about the things that are most important in my life and be willing to let you examine them.**

- 1. What do you value most in your life?**
- 2. Do you think that you are giving your best to God?**
- 3. What does a look at your calendar or time show about what is most important to you?**
